

## Building the *Number One Chair*

During week long, hands-on classes, renowned furniture maker Michael A. Doerre demonstrates the building techniques he uses to make his original design, the *Number One Chair*. He teaches students a system of construction and leg seat joinery based on the use of a table saw, band saw, router and simple hand tools. Each student starts with a set of wooden blocks, prepared by Michael, that are assembled with WEST SYSTEM® epoxy. After this five day

class, students leave with their chair, and a knowledge of the design elements necessary for creating their own chairs—seat to back relationship, comfort, selection of appropriate woods and grain considerations. Classes are held at the Doerr Woodworking Studio in Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin. The week long course is limited to one or two student participants, and is available by appointment.
